



INDUSTRY MAKES COMMUNITIES STRONGER

Industrial facilities are managed and operated by Louisiana's own citizens. Local site managers maintain strong, safe communities for themselves, their families, and their neighbors.

Industry Pays Taxes

Industrial facilities account for 2/3 of Louisiana's property tax dollars collected in the Capitol Region. This number is even higher in neighboring parishes. Industry pays 50 percent of all sales taxes collected in the state.

Investment decisions to build in Louisiana are aided by the Industrial Property Tax Exemption (ITEP) program offered by the state, and once committed the sales and property taxes generated benefit a community immediately.

Community Projects and Contributions

Upon development in a community, facilities construct projects that last for generations. Many plants in Louisiana have celebrated more than 50 years of operations and some more than 100. Industry takes a long-term view when making investments. Industry members partner with their communities and build roads, parks and community centers as a few examples.
