## Scholarships

Louisiana's industry members provide many scholarships to local community members. A few examples include scholarships for PTECH Associate's degrees and skilled craft training at Louisiana's Community and Technical Colleges and at the Associated Builders and Contractors Craft Training Centers. Industry also donates to local Union organizations to support their craft training programs.

## Donations

Industry donates millions to Louisiana's schools including elementary, middle and high schools to community colleges and universities. More than \$150 million have been donated in recent years to many programs and schools.

## Steering Education

Industry members serve on curriculum advisory boards for many schools including Louisiana's Community and Technical Colleges, Associated Builders and Contractors, Board of Regents, and Universities.

## Student Experiences

Industry hires interns in engineering and skilled craft fields and even trains teachers in "summer institutes." Industry donates equipment and laboratory resources to schools, and examples include a hydroponics lab, robotics equipment, and chemistry labs at area museums.
